WINEMAKER`S NOTES

With a bracing lingering vibrancy, this wine shows enhancing notes of green fig, melon and ripe apple. A summery fragrant nose including blossoms and wild flowers makes it a white fit to finish any green.

A lively fresh acidity and a quirky sherbet-lemon finish round off a crowd-pleasing wine which is great to on its own or with a summer salad.
